Despite this, she maintained strong connections in both Switzerland and the United States as she frequently splits her time between both countries. This allows her to display her art globally using multiple aesthetics of each country as a muse.

Kelly stated, "My work begins to emerge as color and texture are added layer by layer.

Landscapes push the viewer to a world of color, light, and emotion. Much of the result is driven by unconscious creative
